APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- High school diploma (translated into English or Turkish)
- Official transcript showing courses/grades taken in high school, approved by the school administration (translated into English or Turkish)
- Valid exam result document as accepted under Article 7 of the Harran University International Student Admission Directive (translated into English or Turkish)

- Biometric photograph
- Passport (translated into English or Turkish)
- Applicants with a Turkish language proficiency certificate issued by TÖMER must upload their document during the application process (optional)
- Identity card
- For Turkish citizens who graduated via distance education abroad: “Entry-Exit Document” is mandatory
- For individuals who later acquired Turkish citizenship: “Family Registry Record” is mandatory

NOTES AND WARNINGS

- Applications must be completed online via the Student Information System: **obs.harran.edu.tr/oibs/foa_app/**
- Applicants may choose a maximum of five (5) programs
- Any application, placement, or registration based on falsified, forged, incomplete, or incorrect documents will be CANCELLED
- Students without a diploma equivalency may apply (however, foreign nationals must submit the equivalency certificate within one semester after final registration)
- Applicants with an ABITUR certificate must enter their grades based on a 100-point scale
- For any issues regarding the application process, please contact: int@harran.edu.tr
- International, national, and TR-YÖS (Turkey International Student Admission Exam organized by ÖSYM) exam results as specified in the Harran University International Student Admission Directive are accepted for applications

- For candidates who were Turkish citizens by birth but lost citizenship through permission from the Ministry of Interior, blue card holders, and dual citizens (one nationality being Turkish) who completed their high school education abroad (excluding TRNC): enrollment in Teacher Education, Law, Pharmacy, Medicine, and Dentistry programs will not exceed 10% of the total quota for these programs
